

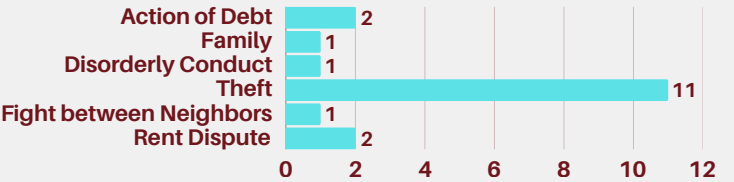

REACH AND ACTIVITY

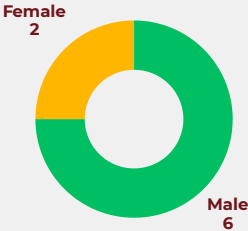
- # of Mediators/Paralegals = 3

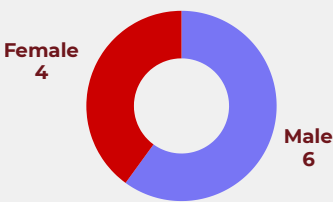
