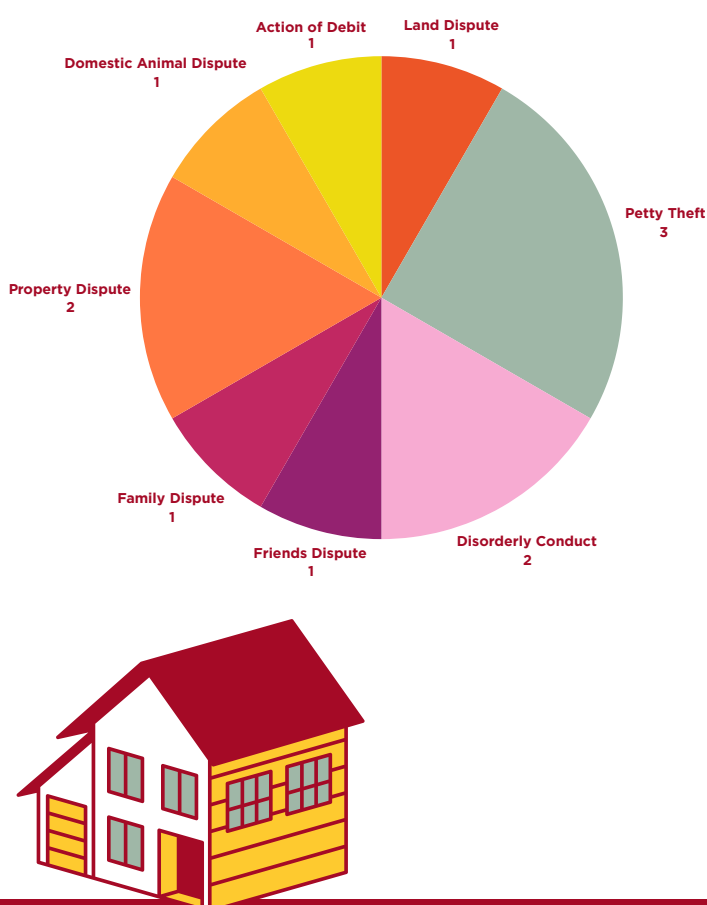

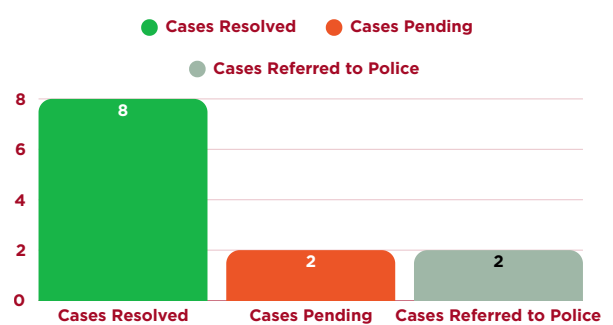

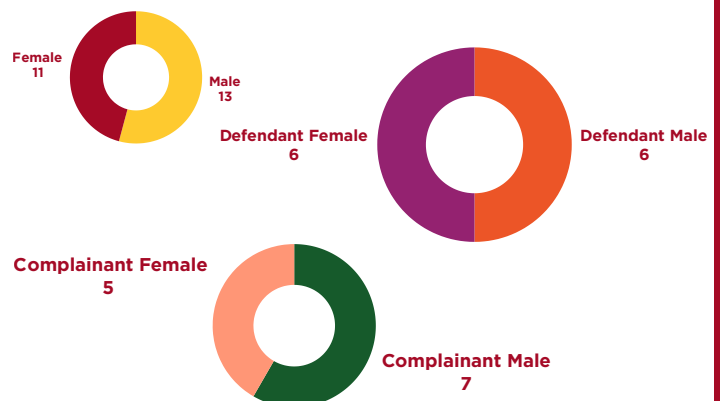

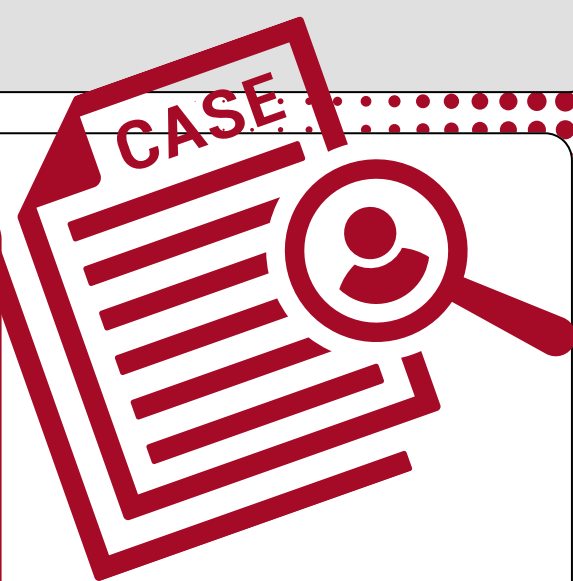
Grassroots mediation fosters peaceful and fair conflict resolution. Here's what our dedicated mediators and paralegals accomplished in July 2025.

- » Total # of Cases referred = 0

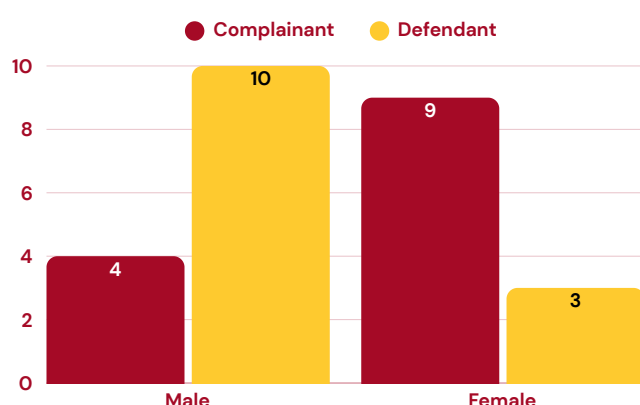
Types of cases
